<i>Linden lime on the aroma. Mango and green apple on the palate. A sauvignon from one of the great wine estates of France.</i>

<i>Burgundian style chardonnay. Ripe tropical fruit, rich mouthfeel, and delicious natural acidity.</i>

<i>Aromas of citrus, pear and vanilla, with hints of toasty oak. Mouth-coating viscosity balanced by naturally fresh, crisp acidity.</i>

<i>Tropical fruit, lemon and hazelnuts dominate from the start but the wine finishes with lovely elegant notes.</i>
